MATERIAL NEEDED minimum

Lights 14 PC 1KW + 1 découpe 1 KW

Little wall 4 with legs (legs of at least 80 cm) + black painting if we need to do some

retouching

Floor dance mat de 8 X 8 meters (minimum)

Sound 1 amplifier may be asked when touring out of Belgium

LOCATION


A clean space, big enough for 2 dancers in movement, a live musician and the audience. In a space of 10x10 M, we ask the next disposition:

Disposition of the audience

In an arc around the set, sitting on pillows or on a bench close to the stage.

Floor

On the stage a wooden floor and a dance mat are required. In case of a hard floor (concrete or tiles), we ask to install a practicable floor that will be covered with a dance mat.



LITTLE WALL


A vertical wall with a smooth surface, stable and constructed by the stage manager at the location. As the dancer throws him on the wall this one has to be very stable! There are several building possibilities in function of your location and material available.

Find here the 3 possibilities:


a) In the shape of a BOX:4 adaptable podium stagings with legs,8 legs of 80 cm, 2 joints for the podium stagings.

SOUND


THE MUSICIAN has his own material: guitar, banjo, little instruments, and amplifier. Out of Belgium, it can be that we ask for 1 or 2 amplifiers type Fender deluxe Reverb, Fender Princeton, Fender twin Reverb, Fender deville or Vox ac30.

LIGHTS

Plan

The stage manager has to take care of the set up, the follow up and lighting. The lighting has to be tested, verified with the dancers before the performance.

As indicated on next page.



Contre: the whole set beside the wall and the pillows.

Face : the whole set beside the pillows. Découpe : light lane until the wall

PC8 : in front of the wall

PC9 : front of the musician

FOLLOWING LIGHTS

Will be explained and verified during the rehearsal:

Entrance of the audience: salle + SUB1 (contre 6 et 7 + PC9) The audience is installed: salle \mathbf{a} + SUB2 \mathbf{a} (face 1&2 + 4&5)

The musician takes his banjo + solo dancer: SUB3 **7** (découpe 3) + SUB2 **1**0% + SUB1 **1**50%

When the dancer arrives on the wall: SUB4 7 (face8)

When the dancer gets off the wall: SUB5 **7** (face 1&2 + contre 100%) + SUB4**3**

The dancer says: « je dégouline » (when the dancers slides from the wall) : SUB 1&2 **7**+ SUB4**1**
